Oct .06: USA - LISBON (Portugal)

Oct 07: LISBON - FATIMA



On arrival, if time allows, enjoy a panoramic drive through the new and old parts of Lisbon including Belem Tower, Monument of the Discoveries, Jeronimo's Monastery, and the birthplace of the beloved St. Anthony. Continue to Fatima, one of the most famous Marian shrines in the world for a visit to the Sanctuary. Check-in to your hotel close to the shrine area. You may join the Candlelight Procession after dinner.

Oct 08: FATIMA - SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA (SPAIN)

Enjoy a buffet breakfast at the hotel. A guided tour will include the Capelinha (Apparition Chapel), the Basilica which contains the tombs of the 3 visionaries, Bl. Jacinta, Bl. Oct 09: SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA - BURGOS



Breakfast at the hotel. Visit the Plaza del Obradeiro which has important monuments, including the Cathedral of St. James. Its current Baroque facade gives way to a Romanesque doorway from the original building, the Portico de Gloria, created by master Mateo in the 12th century, Archbishop's Palace and Rajoy Palace. Walk the oldest streets of the city which date from the 12th century - Ruas Franco, Vilar and Nova. Continue to the city of Burgos. Dinner and overnight.

Oct 10: BURGOS - MADRID - MILAN (ITALY)

Oct 14: FLORENCE - PISA - ROME
